
Te Aho o Te Kahu – Cancer



have supported people with cancer.




They support us to improve cancer care for everyone in Aotearoa New Zealand.

We very much want **applications** from:


- Māori

He Ara Tangata has up to 12 members.




They know what it is like to have cancer in Aotearoa New Zealand.

He Ara Tangata meets every 3 months.




Meetings can be:


